<b>Day 2</b>	<p><b>Incheon – The Independence Hall of Korea (★Includes 1 way mini train ride) – Jeonju Hanok Village – Korean Traditional Wine Museum – Jeonju Traditional Culture Center (★Experience Korean Wedding Ceremony )</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The Independence Hall of Korea</b> : Displays Korean historical documents and relics from past to present, mainly focusing on the independence movements of the Japanese Colonial Period to August 15, 1987.</li> <li>• <b>Jeonju Hanok Village</b> : There are over 800 traditional Korean 'hanok' houses. It is especially beautiful for its roof curves. The roof edges being slightly raised to the sky is unique.</li> <li>• <b>Experience Korean Wedding Ceremony</b> : A traditional ceremonial hall called Hwamyeongwon is a space in which a man and a woman make a promise, and their wedding is blessed. It consists of all the ritual and formal procedures from the marriage proposal to the bridegroom's trip to his bride's house.</li> </ul>
<b>Day 3</b>	<p><b>Jeonju – Jeungdo Island Slow City ★(Salt Cave Healing Center, Salt Museum) – Mokpo</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Salt Cave Healing Center</b>: As the temperature inside of the cave is kept around 20-23°C the visitors can breathe fine salt particles continuously, it is very effective for healing, beauty care and psychological stability.</li> </ul>
<b>Day 4</b>	<p><b>Mokpo – ★Mt.Dooryun with cable car – Boseong Green Tea Farm – Songgwangsa Temple – Hwasun</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Mt.Dooryun</b> : Is the auspicious mountain of Haenam comprised of a chain of 8 higher and lower peaks. Enjoy the view of the vast plains and archipelago.</li> <li>• <b>Songgwangsa Temple</b> : This is the temple that produced the largest number of renowned priests of Korea in addition to 16 most revered priests.</li> </ul>
<b>Day 5</b>	<p><b>Hwasun – ★Beartree Park – ★Yongin Everland (with entrance and passport) – Seoul – Dongdaemun</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Beartree Park</b> : Home to over 150 Asiatic black bears, reindeers and carps.</li> <li>• <b>Everland</b> : A large theme park with safari zoo, and botanical garden. Among of this all, the <b>Liger</b> in the safari zoo is reason for most of the people to visit on.</li> </ul>
