Day 3	Jeju Island – ★Seongsan Sunrise Peak – Korean Movie "All In" Shooting Place (Seopjikoji Hill) – ★Teseum Safari – ★Jeju Horse Riding ** (If weather not permitted, will change to Jeju Horse Show) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seongsan Sunrise Park : is one of 360 parasitic volcanoes, the world's biggest crater at seacoast.
Day 4	Jeju Island → Busan Airport – Jagalchi Seafood Market – Gyeongju – ★Bulguksa Temple – ★Seokguram Grotto – Daegu <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jagalchi Market : Korea's largest fish market since 1889 is a must-go destination for all seafood lovers out there! The market offers every type of fish and seafood you can imagine and serves it in a very unique way (at least very different from Western culture). You can also eat all the sashimi you wish for a very reasonable price! • Bulguksa Temple : The temple is considered as a masterpiece of the golden age of Buddhist art in the Silla kingdom. The beauty of the temple itself and the artistic touch of the stone relics are known throughout the world. • Seokguram Grotto : It exemplifies some of the best Buddhist sculptures in the world. The construction started with Kim Dae-Seong (700~774) in 751 during the reign of King Gyeong-Deok (742~765) of the Silla Dynasty (57 B.C.~A.D. 935) and it was finished twenty-four years later in 774, during the reign of King Hye-Gong (765~780).
Day 5	Daegu – Jeonju – Jeonju Hanok Village – ★Korean Traditional Wine Museum – Jeonju Traditional Culture Center (★Experience Korean Wedding Ceremony) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jeonju Hanok Village : There are over 800 traditional Korean 'hanok' houses. It is especially beautiful for its roof curves. The roof edges being slightly raised to the sky is unique. • Experience Korean Wedding Ceremony : A traditional ceremonial hall called Hwamyeongwon is a space in which a man and a woman make a promise, and their wedding is blessed. It consists of all the ritual and formal procedures from the marriage proposal to the bridegroom's trip to his bride's house.
Day 6	Jeonju – The Independence Hall of Korea (★includes 1 way mini train ride) – ★Yongin Everland (with entrance and passport) – Seoul – Dongdaemun <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Independence Hall of Korea : Displays Korean historical documents and relics from past to present, mainly focusing on the independence movements of the Japanese Colonial Period to August 15, 1987. • Everland : A large theme park with safari zoo, and botanical garden. Among this all, the Liger in the safari zoo is reason for most of the people to visit on. (**Winter time replace with Lotte World)
Day 7	Seoul – ★Gyeongbok Palace – Drive pass The Blue House – National Ginseng Outlet – Cordyceps Shop + HD-1 Tab Gold – Cosmetic Duty Free – Myeongdong – ★Nanta Show <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nanta Show : Discover the combination of Korea traditional percussion and modern styles performance.
