2 Barcelona (WD)

- Enjoy the oriental city tour and panoramic view to **Town Hall Palace, Passeig de Colom, Monumenta of Christopher Columbus, Avinguda Miramar, Montjuich Mountain, Port harbour and the Olympic complex. Guell Park.**
- ✨ Entrance to **La Sagrada Familia Church** ~ sublime Cathedral and the ancient winding streets of the Gothic

Quarter, an unfinished masterpiece of this world-famous architect - it's a temple of Gaudi's most emblematic work, and a symbol of Barcelona all over the world.

3 Barcelona - Montserrat - 379km Valencia (Spain) (B/CL/Seafood Paella D)

- ✨ **Montserrat by 2 way funicular ride**, situated 4'055 feet above sea level in a mountain range composed of strikingly pink conglomerate, a form of sedimentary rock

and site of a Benedictine abbey which host the virgin of Montserrat Sanctuary, the monastery was found in 1025 and the current sanctuary dates from 592.

- Do not miss the ❄️ **Montserrat museum (included entrance)** to know more about the ancient history.
- **Valencia** is the capital of the Spanish autonomous community of Valencia and its province. It is the third largest city in Spain and the 21st largest in the European Union.

4 Valencia - Murcia - 554km Granada (Spain) (B/CL/WD)

- Proceed for Valencia city tour of **Town Hall, La Lonja, the Bull Ring** and passing the massive gateway towers of **Serranos** and **Quart**.
- Continue to GRANADA via MURCIA.
- **Murcia** is the capital city of the Autonomous Community of the Region of Murcia, located at the river Segura in south-eastern Spain. Its population is 433,850 (2008), and the population of its metropolitan area is 743,326 ranking as the ninth-largest metropolitan area of Spain.

5 Granada - 258km Seville (Spain) (B/WL/WD-Flamenco show)

- **Granada** is placed at the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountain, at the confluence of three rivers, Beiro, Darro and Genil, at an elevation of 738 metres above sea level yet only one hour from the Mediterranean coast, the Costa Tropical.
- ❄️ **La Alhambra** with inside visit was a palace, a citadel, a fortress and home of the Nasrid Sultans, high government officials, servants of the court and elite soldiers of the Nasrid Dynasty (1238-1492), the last Islamic sultanate in the Iberian Peninsula.
- Visit to ❄️ **The Palacio de Generalife (included entrance)** was the summer palace and country estate of the Nasrid sultans of Granada.
- **Seville** ~ Seville is located in the South of Spain.

6 Seville (Spain) – 187km Badajoz (B/CL/WD)

- ❄️ **The Cathedral of Seville** (included entrance), was built in the 15th and 16th century in Gothic style on the grounds of the former major Arab mosque. It is the largest place of worship in Spain, and the third largest cathedral in the Christian world.
- Climb up to the ❄️ **Giralda Tower & Cathedral** (included entrance), which was the minaret of the 12th century Moslem mosque. Its Christian bell fry was added by Hernán Ruiz in 1568. From there you can oversee large parts of Seville.
- Transfer to **Badajoz**, the largest province in Spain. Badajoz borders with Caceres in the North, Huelva, Seville and Cordoba in the South, and Ciudad Real and Toledo in the East.

7 Badajoz – 241km Lisbon (Portugal) (B/CL/WD)

Lisbon ~ this is the Capital City of Portuguese and is situated along the River Tagus where it's crystal clear waves flow and mingles with the open waters of the Atlantic Ocean.

- ❄️ **Belém Tower** (included entrance) is a fortified tower located in the Belém district of Lisbon, Portugal. It was built in the early 16th century in the Portuguese late Gothic style, the Manueline, to commemorate Vasco da Gama's expedition. In 1983 it was classified, together with the nearby Mosteiro dos Jerónimos, as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- ❄️ **Hieronymites Monastery** (included entrance) ~ Is the most impressive symbol of Portugal's power and wealth during the Age of Discovery and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

8 Lisbon (Portugal) – 498km Caceres (Spain) (B/CL/WD)

- **Lisbon** ~ Free & Leisure in this beautiful city before transfer back to Caceres, Spain.
- The province of **Caceres** is one of the most beautiful in Spain. Intact historical cities, sleepy rural towns and beautiful natural reserves.

9 Caceres – 256km Toledo – 73km Madrid (Spain) (B/WL/Suckling Pig D)

- **Toledo** ~ is a city and municipality located in central Spain, 70 km south of Madrid. It is the capital of the province of Toledo and of the autonomous community of Castile-La Mancha. It was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1986 for its extensive cultural and monumental heritage as one of the former capitals of the Spanish Empire and place of coexistence of Christian, Jewish and Moorish cultures.
- Toledo orientation city tour to ❄️ **Gothic Cathedral & Church of Santo Tome** with one of E1 Greco's most famous paintings.
- Transfer to MADRID.

10 Madrid (Spain) (B/WL/Tapas D)

- **Madrid** is time and again listed and described in all Spain guidebooks.
- The ❄️ **Royal Palace of Madrid (included entrance)** is the official residence of the King of Spain.
