We next head for the <u>Dolphin Lagoon</u> where you get the opportunity to marvel at the performance of intelligent pink dolphins. Hop onto the island's shuttle and head for the <u>Merlion</u>, standing on a 23m high hillock overlooking Sentosa. It offers a 360 degree view</p>

Morning at Singapore Zoo (Daily/4H) Pickup/Commence: 0800H/0830H	148	108	The <u>Singapore Zoo</u> is a model of the 'open zoo' concept. The animals are kept in spacious, landscaped enclosures, separated from the visitors by dry or wet moats. The moats are concealed with vegetation or dropped below the line of vision. In the case of dangerous animals such as leopards and jaguars which can climb very well, moat barriers are not used. Instead, these animals are housed in beautifully landscaped glass-fronted enclosures. Oppressive cages which typify old zoos are absent. The end result is a feeling of openness. Tired of having the usual breakfast? Then choose to feast with an orang utan, the Oriental small-clawed otter, or even the reticulated python! Tour ends at DFS Orchard or hotel.

Nestled in 40 hectares of lush secondary forest, the Night Safari offers guests the unique experience of exploring wildlife in a tropical jungle at night. Roam the jungle in the complete safety and comfort Tram which takes you through the East and West Loop passing by a large reservoir and weaving through selected habitats designed specifically to replicate the natural environment from the Himalayan Foothills to the Southeast Asian Rainforest and Indian Subcontinent. Tour ends at hotel.

Jurong Bird Park with tram (Daily/3.5H) Pickup/Commence: 0800H/0830H	148	118	Jurong Bird Park is a 20.2 hectare open-concept park. It is the largest in the Asia Pacific and the best in the world. Its collection of more than 8,000 birds from 600 species is among the largest in the world. The Park specialises in birds from Southeast Asia. The Park has four walk-in aviaries, among which the world's largest walk-in aviary with the tallest man-made waterfall for visitors to enjoy a close-up view of free-flying birds from Africa. Bird shows, staged at the Pools Amphitheatre and Fuji Hawk Walk are entertaining and informative and have thrilled visitors from all over the world. The Bird Park's exhibits and aviaries are specially designed to closely resemble the natural habitats of the birds. There are also open spaces landscaped with exotic flowering plants such as heliconias to enhance the beauty of the Bird Park. Tour ends at DFS Orchard or hotel.
